To Whom It May Concern,

There have been a number of inquiries concerning the animal consumption restriction on UPI's Aquathol K/Cascade and Hydrothol/Teton labels. The restriction is under the Directions for Use section and states that for quiescent or slow moving water treatments, treated water should not be used for animal consumption within specified time periods after application (depending on the application rate).

The question posed is how does this restriction apply to incidental exposure? We have discussed this issue with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and confirmed that the label restriction refers only to the intentional use of water from a treated body of water, for example, the use of treated water for livestock watering. The animal consumption restriction does not apply to the incidental exposure to animals from treated water, for example, a pet drinking from a treated water body.
